Use of Tennis Courts at Harding Green

To assure that all Harding Green residents have fair and equal access to the tennis courts, to provide as pleasant an environment as possible, to avoid damage to the tennis courts, and to respect the rights of all residents who use the courts, the following rules have been adopted by the Board of Trustees:

Use of Tennis Courts

The tennis courts are to be used exclusively for tennis play. All other activities are prohibited. Use of the courts is strictly limited to Harding Green residents and their guests. When members invite guests, the members must be on the court with their guests and are responsible to see that their guests comply with the rules.

Tennis Dress and Footwear

Regulation flat-soled tennis shoes are required. Running shoes or other footwear that mark or otherwise damage the playing surface are not permitted. Shirts must be worn while on the courts.

Maintenance and Clean-Up

Trash must be placed in trash containers and not strewn about the court. Sharp lids from tennis ball containers are a particular hazard. Players who use the roller to dry the court must return the roller to its storage location on the fence.

Rules of Etiquette

Players are expected to adhere to the normal rules and customs of tennis and to avoid disrupting or interfering with play on the adjacent court.

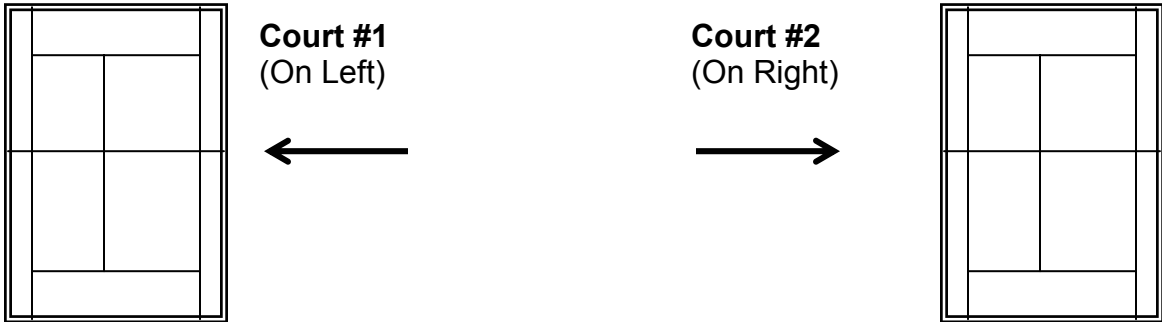
Court Reservations and Sign-up

During the active tennis season, a sign-up sheet will be posted at the poolhouse entrance. Reservation regulations are stated below:

Residents of each housing unit can reserve one court session per day for play. Singles players may reserve for 1 hour; doubles players may reserve for 1-½ hours. At completion of the court session (sessions end on the hour or half hour) the players must vacate the court if others are waiting, regardless of the score. If the courts are vacant, residents who have already used their daily reservation limit may use the courts on a first-come basis but they may not reserve again that day. Children under the age of 16 years may not reserve after 6:00 p.m. weekdays, or before noon weekends or holidays, unless they are sharing the court with adults.

Residents are encouraged to resolve and negotiate disputes over reservations in a friendly and sportsmanlike manner by sharing courts or by splitting times.
